In the Town of Wake Forest, North Carolina*

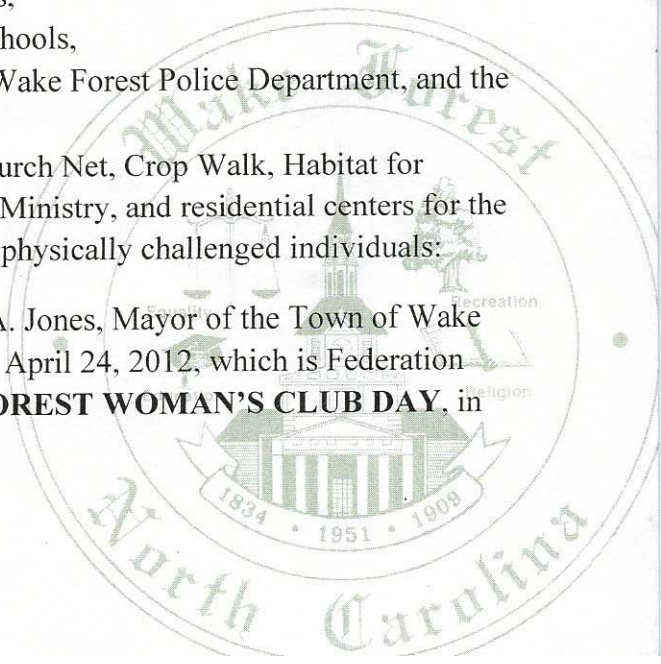
WHEREAS, on September 7, 1961, the Wake Forest Woman’s Club began its first year of service to the Town of Wake Forest and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Wake Forest Woman’s Club is an all-volunteer service organization whose objective is the civic, cultural, educational, intellectual, and social betterment of the community and individuals; and

WHEREAS, the Wake Forest Woman’s Club, a member of the international General Federation of Women’s Clubs, and its members have enhanced the community of Wake Forest through their commitment to volunteer service, including:


1. The establishment and support of the Wake Forest Public Library,
2. The restoration of the Calvin Jones House,
3. The continued support of the Wake Forest Historical Museum,
4. The establishment of an academic scholarship and the awarding of this scholarship to a Wake Forest-Rolesville High School graduating senior annually since 1971,
5. The participation in the annual Arbor Day and Fourth of July Art in the Park celebrations for the children of the Wake Forest community,
6. The mentoring and tutoring of students in local schools,
7. The promotion of the arts in the community and our schools,
8. The support of the Wake Forest Fire Department, the Wake Forest Police Department, and the Wake Forest Police and Veterans’ Memorials,
9. The support of Back Pack Buddies, Book Buddies, Church Net, Crop Walk, Habitat for Humanity, Meals on Wheels, Relay for Life, Tri-Area Ministry, and residential centers for the homeless, women, children, seniors, and mentally and physically challenged individuals:

Jones, Mayor of the Town of Wake Forest, do hereby call on the citizens of Wake Forest to recognize April 24, 2012, which is Federation Day for the General Federation of Women’s Clubs, as **WAKE FOREST WOMAN’S CLUB DAY**, in celebration of the 50th anniversary of this esteemed organization;
