# District VI Constitution

## ARTICLE I. Name

The name is District VI of the General Federation of Women's Clubs of North Carolina, hereinafter referred to as GFWC-NC.

## ARTICLE II. Purposes

The purposes are:

1. To promote the programs of GFWC-NC and GFWC in the clubs.
2. To organize and federate additional clubs.
3. To conduct any other activity which is in harmony with the objectives of GFWC-NC and GFWC.

## ARTICLE III. Membership

The membership is comprised of local clubs federated with GFWC-NC and located in Chatham, Cumberland, Durham, Harnett, Hoke, Lee, Moore, Orange and Wake Counties, subject to payment of district dues.

## ARTICLE IV. Officers

The officers are: President, First Vice President, Second Vice President, Junior Director (who shall be a Junior Clubwoman), Junior Membership Chairman (who shall be a Junior Clubwoman), Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, and Treasurer.

## ARTICLE V. Standing Committees

There shall be the following Standing Committees: Audit, Awards, Chrysalis Woman's Club, Community Improvement Program, Constitution and Bylaws, Finance, GFWC Clubwoman, North Carolina Clubwoman, Newsletter Awards, Nominating and Publicity.

## ARTICLE VI. The Annual District Meeting

- A. The Annual District Meeting shall be held in the Fall at a place recommended by the Executive Committee that is easily accessible to all clubs. The place recommended shall be accepted at the previous District Meeting. Members of the clubs within the District attending the meeting constitute the delegate body.
- B. The delegate body is authorized to act upon recommendations from the Executive Committee and the Board of Directors, to vote on committee reports and to transact other necessary business.
- C. All Clubwomen in the District are invited to attend the Fall Annual Meeting. The District President shall issue the call 30 days prior to the meeting. The Call shall be sent to all Club Presidents in the District and to District Department and Program Chairmen, Committee members, Past District Presidents, and members of the District serving GFWC-NC and GFWC. Each Club President is expected to encourage members of her club to attend the Annual Meeting.

## **ARTICLE VII. Amendments**

This constitution may be amended at any District Annual Meeting by a two-thirds vote of the delegate body present and voting, notice of the proposed amendments having been appended to the Call of the District Meeting.

# **District VI Bylaws**

## **ARTICLE I. Name**

The name shall be General Federation of Women's Clubs of North Carolina (GFWC-NC) District VI.

## **ARTICLE II. Object**

The Object is:

1. To promote the programs of GFWC-NC and GFWC in the clubs.
2. To promote club work in general throughout the District.
3. To organize and federate additional clubs.
4. To conduct any other activity which is in harmony with the objectives of GFWC-NC and GFWC.

## **ARTICLE III. Membership**

The membership is comprised of local clubs federated with GFWC-NC and located in Chatham, Cumberland, Durham, Harnett, Hoke, Lee, Moore, Orange, and Wake Counties subject to payment of District dues.

## **ARTICLE IV. Officers and Their Election**

**Section 4.1.** The officers shall be: President, Vice President-Membership, Vice President-Communications and Public Relations, Junior Director (who shall be a Junior Clubwoman), Junior Membership Chairman (who shall be a Junior Clubwoman), Secretary, and Treasurer.

**Section 4.2.** Officers shall be elected at the Annual Meeting in uneven years, and the election of the President, Junior Director, Vice President-Membership, and Junior Membership Chairman shall be confirmed at the following GFWC-NC Convention. District Officers are elected for a two-year term. They assume office upon adjournment of the GFWC-NC Convention.

## **ARTICLE V. Executive Committee**

The officers of the District constitute the Executive Committee. Three members constitute a quorum. The Committee shall meet at the call of the President, or upon the written request of any two of its members. It has the authority to transact business of the District between meetings of the Board of

Directors and the Annual Meeting. It may vote by mail, conference call, email, or other electronic means. A report of action taken in this manner shall be ratified and made a part of the minutes of the next meeting of the Board of Directors. In order for the Executive Committee to conduct a vote by mail, conference call, email, or other electronic means, all members of the committee must be able to participate in the same manner. It has the responsibility for designating a city for Summer Meetings (when needed), Annual Meetings and Arts Festivals.

## **ARTICLE VI. Board of Directors**

**Section 6.1.** The Executive Committee, Club Presidents, Chaplain, Historian, Parliamentarian, District Community Service Program and Committee Chairmen constitute the Board of Directors. The Board shall meet between Annual Meetings and at the call of the President or upon written request of one fourth of its membership. It may delegate to the Executive Committee such power as it deems necessary provided that such power does not entail expenditure of funds. The Board of Directors may vote by mail, conference call, email or other electronic means. A report of action taken in this manner shall be ratified and made a part of the minutes of the next meeting of the Board of Directors. In order for the Board of Directors to conduct a vote by mail, conference call, email or other electronic means, all members of the committee must be able to participate in the same manner. A quorum shall be a majority of the members present.

**Section 6.2.** The duties of the Board of Directors may be outlined in the District VI Policies and Procedures published in the current District Yearbook.

## **ARTICLE VII. Program of Work**

The District shall participate in the program of work of GFWC-NC. The number and titles of Community Service Programs shall be determined by GFWC and GFWC-NC. The number and titles of special committees shall be determined by the Executive Committee. Officers and Community Service Program Chairmen may meet with their GFWC-NC counterparts during times scheduled by GFWC-NC.

## **ARTICLE VIII. District Meetings**

**Section 8.1.** The Annual Meeting shall be held in the fall at a city recommended by the Executive Committee that is easily accessible to all club members. Members of the clubs within the District attending the meeting constitute the delegate body.

**Section 8.2.** The delegate body is authorized to act upon recommendations from the Executive Committee and the Board of Directors, to vote on committee reports and to transact other necessary business.

**Section 8.3.** All Clubwomen in the District are invited to attend District Meetings. The District President shall issue the Official Call at least 30 days prior to each District Meeting. The Call shall be sent to members of the District Board of Directors; to Past District Presidents and Past Junior Directors who are dues paying members of a District Club, to members of the District serving GFWC-NC and GFWC; to the GFWC-NC President, President-elect, Vice Presidents and to all GFWC and GFWC-NC Past Presidents and Directors of Juniors residing in the District. Each Club President is expected to encourage members of her club to attend District Meetings.

**Section 8.4.** There shall be a Summer Meeting, when needed.

**Section 8.5.** There shall be an Annual District Arts Festival with contests in the Arts sponsored by Clubs, the District and the GFWC-NC to promote education in the arts among clubwomen and students.

## **ARTICLE IX. Finances**

**Section 9.1.** The fiscal year of the District shall be from July 1<sup>st</sup> through June 30<sup>th</sup>.

**Section 9.2.** The annual budget for the following fiscal year shall be submitted by the Finance Committee to the Executive Committee for approval and to the District at the Annual Meeting for adoption.

**Section 9.3.** Approval by the Executive Committee is required prior to the opening and closing of any accounts maintained for banking purposes.

**Section 9.4.** All financial records shall be reviewed annually by the Audit Committee by August 31<sup>st</sup>.

**Section 9.5.** District fees and dues shall be paid to the Treasurer of District VI in accordance with the provisions set forth in the Policies and Procedures. Club dues to the District and State must be current in order for a club to be eligible to participate in any level of Federation activities.

**Section 9.6.** The District or any Club in the District having any bank accounts must have two names of elected officers on both the account and the signature card. All Bank accounts must carry the full name of the District or Club. No account shall be opened in the name of an individual member.

## **ARTICLE X. Duties of Officers**

**Section 10.1. President.** The President shall preside at all meetings of the District and shall be chairman of the Executive Committee and Board of Directors. She shall serve as ex-officio member of all committees except the Nominating Committee. She shall cooperate with the GFWC-NC Second Vice President to promote club work in general throughout the District. She shall appoint a Chaplain, Historian, Parliamentarian, Standing Committees, and such Special Committees as may be necessary for the administration. She shall issue the Call to the Summer Meeting (when needed), Annual Meeting and the Arts Festival at least 30 days prior to the meeting date, prepare the printed program for the Annual Meeting and coordinate all facets of the meeting. She shall visit the clubs in the District upon invitation from the respective clubs. Before the Annual Meeting she shall send a copy of the District Yearbook to the GFWC-NC Second Vice President. After the Annual Meeting and Arts Festival, she shall send to the GFWC-NC Second Vice President a copy of the minutes of the meeting and the numbers in attendance. She shall discharge such other responsibilities as shall be incumbent upon the office. The Vice Presidents in the order of their election shall perform the duties of the President in her absence. The President shall coordinate with Community Service Program Chairmen to plan District Community Service Program workshops and activities.

**Section 10.2. Vice President-Membership.** It shall be the duty of the Vice President-Membership to assist the President. The Vice President-Membership shall promote membership extension within the District in cooperation with the President, the Junior Director and the Junior Membership Chairman through organizing and federating additional clubs. She shall serve as Chairman of Membership for the District and work closely with the Junior Membership Chairman. She shall serve as a member of the GFWC-NC Membership Committee and as Chairman of the District Membership Committee. She shall cooperate with the GFWC-NC President-elect to promote extension through increase in membership and through organizing and federating new clubs. Should a vacancy occur in the office of President, the Vice President-Membership shall become President and serve the remainder of the term.

**Section 10.3. Vice President-Communications and Public Relations.** With the President, the Vice President-Communications and Public Relations shall be responsible for internal and external communications including the publication and distribution of the District Yearbook and Newsletters and Public Relations activity such as publicizing the District meetings and activities in cooperation with the District President. She shall be responsible for updating the existing Bylaws and Policies and Procedures in the District Yearbook in cooperation with the Bylaws Chairman after the amendments are adopted.

**Section 10.4. Junior Director.** The Junior Director shall supervise and promote the work among the Junior Clubs within the District in cooperation with the GFWC-NC Third Vice President. She shall be a clubwoman of Junior age. She shall cooperate with the President, the Vice President-Membership and the Junior Membership Chairman in the extension of District work by attempting to organize and federate additional clubs, particularly among women of Junior Club age. She shall visit Junior clubs in the District upon invitation of the respective clubs. She shall assist the President and in the absence of the President and Vice Presidents shall preside at the meetings of the District.

**Section 10.5. Junior Membership Chairman.** The Junior Membership Chairman shall promote membership growth within the District, working closely with the President, the Vice President-Membership and the Junior Director. She shall be a member of the GFWC-NC Membership Committee. She shall cooperate with the GFWC-NC Director-elect of Junior Clubs to promote membership and assist in the organization and federation of new clubs.

**Section 10.6. Secretary.** The Secretary shall keep the minutes of all meetings of the District and of the Executive Committee and the Board of Directors. She shall supply the President and other officers with a copy of the minutes of the meeting no later than two weeks after the meeting. She shall conduct a roll call at the Annual Meeting.

**Section 10.7. Treasurer.** The Treasurer shall have charge and custody of and be responsible for all funds of the District, receive dues and pay all expenses of the District authorized by the budget, and those non-authorized expenses as approved by the President. Requests for reimbursement of expenses covered by the budget must be submitted to the Treasurer no later than June 15<sup>th</sup> of each year. She shall keep a written record of all business transactions, and prepare accurate financial statements for presentation at each District meeting during the fiscal year, or at the request of the President. She shall meet with the Audit Committee Chairman at each District meeting in order for the Audit Committee Chairman to review the bank statements and reconciliation reports. She shall serve as Chairman of the Finance Committee, which shall prepare a proposed budget for the following fiscal year to be presented to the Board of Directors at the Annual Meeting. She shall provide financial records to the Audit Committee by August 31<sup>st</sup> of each year. She shall annually send dues and fees notices to clubs in the District by November 30<sup>th</sup>.

## **ARTICLE XI. Community Service Program Chairmen**

**Section 11.1.** There shall be District Community Service Program Chairmen corresponding to the GFWC and GFWC-NC Community Service Program Chairmen.

**Section 11.2.** The Community Service Program (CSP) Chairmen shall receive applicable award entries, have them judged and present the winners at the Awards Session at the District Arts Festival.

**Section 11.3.** The Nominating Committee shall submit nominations for District Community Service Program Chairmen to the Board of Directors for information prior to election for a two-year term by the delegate body at the Annual meeting in uneven years.

## ARTICLE XII. Standing Committees

**Section 12.1. Arts Festival.** The Arts Festival Committee shall consist of contest chairmen appointed by the President for implementation of programs and contests as follows: Arts Fest, Crafts, Literature, Music, Photography, Sallie Southall Cotten, and Visual Arts.

**Section 12.2. Audit.** The Audit Committee shall consist of a chairman and two members appointed by the President qualified by training and experience. She shall meet with the Treasurer at each District meeting to review the bank statements and reconciliation reports. It shall be the responsibility of this Committee to review all District financial records annually and to report to the District Board of Directors and delegate body at the Annual Meeting.

**Section 12.3. Awards.** Appointed by the President, the Awards Chairman shall be responsible for the District VI awards process. She shall receive award entries which may correspond to GFWC-NC Community Service Programs, Advancement Areas, Individual Awards, and others. She shall have them judged and present them at the Awards Session at the District Arts Festival. She shall forward the winning entries, if applicable, to the appropriate GFWC-NC Chairmen according to the information in the current GFWC-NC Administration Book.

**Section 12.4. Bylaws.** The Bylaws Committee shall consist of a chairman and two members including the Parliamentarian appointed by the President and shall receive, initiate and consider amendments to the Bylaws. Proposed amendments must be submitted to the Committee by July 1. A copy of the proposed amendments to the Bylaws shall be sent by the Bylaws Chairman to the President eight (8) weeks prior to the Annual Meeting in order for the President to include the proposed amendments to the Bylaws with the Call to the Annual Meeting.

**Section 12.5. Chrysalis Woman's Club.** The Chrysalis Woman's Club Chairman is responsible for scheduling meetings at the Chrysalis Woman's Club at the NC Women's Correctional Center. She shall contact clubs in the District to secure their help in planning the meetings and in donating funds for programs, materials and refreshments.

**Section 12.6. Finance.** The Finance Committee shall consist of four members. These members shall include the President, the immediate Past Treasurer, the Chairman of the Arts Festival, and the Treasurer, who shall serve as chairman. This Committee shall prepare the annual budget, based on expected receipts, to provide funds for the operation of the District.

**Section 12.7. Membership.** The Membership Committee shall consist of a chairman who shall be the Vice President-Membership, the President, the Junior Director, and the Junior Membership Chairman and shall cooperate to promote membership extension within the District through organizing and federating additional clubs.

### Section 12.8. Nominating Committees.

- A. **District Nominating Committee.** The District Nominating Committee consisting of five members shall be elected at the Annual Meeting in even years. This Committee shall be elected from a ballot of names, one from each club in the District, and shall serve until the election of a new committee. No member shall serve two consecutive terms. Each nominee shall have consented to serve, if elected. The Nominating Committee shall meet immediately following their election for the purpose of electing a Chair. The District President shall include in the Call for the Annual Meeting a request for each club president to send the club's nominee for the Nominating Committee to the District President within ten (10) days of receipt of the Call.



It shall be the duty of the District Nominating Committee to nominate candidates for District Officers and Community Service Program Chairmen to be presented to the Board of Directors and to the delegate body at the Annual Meeting in uneven years. Vacancies in District officers shall be filled for the remainder of the term by the Nominating Committee.

- B. **GFWC-NC Nominating Committees.** The District President shall include in the Call for the Annual Meeting in uneven years a request for each club president to send the club's nominees for the GFWC-NC's Nominating Committees to the District President within ten (10) days of receipt of the Call. Clubs shall submit one name for each ballot for 1) the State Nominating Committee for Officers and 2) the State Nominating Committee for Community Service Program and Program Chairmen. 3) Junior Clubs shall submit an additional name for the State Junior Nominating Committee. One member shall be elected to represent the District on each ballot at the State Convention in even years. No member shall serve consecutive terms. Each nominee shall have consented to serve if elected.

### **ARTICLE XIII. Dismissal**

In the event that a member of the District serving in an elected position is unable to or does not perform the duties of the office or should abuse the office, whether by dereliction of duties, conflict of interest, fraud or other inappropriate manner, the governing officers with the highest ranking officer presiding, shall be empowered to convene a special meeting for resolution. The governing officers, based upon the situation and consensus, shall issue a written warning to the member facing dismissal. The office in question shall be declared vacant by majority vote. A replacement shall be chosen by majority vote. The member whose office has been vacated shall be notified in writing of such action and be advised to return all property.

### **ARTICLE XIV. Parliamentary Authority**

Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised shall govern the District in all cases in which they are applicable and in which they are not inconsistent with these Bylaws.

### **Article XV. Ethical Standards**

**Section 15.1 Ethical Standards.** GFWC, GFWC-NC and District VI requires its officers, Board of Directors, and members to observe high standards of ethical conduct in the execution of their duties and responsibilities, as required by law and as specified in these Bylaws and the Policies and Procedures.

**Section 15.2 Confidentiality.** Officers, the Board of Directors, and members shall not disclose confidential or proprietary information belonging to GFWC, GFWC-NC or District VI or obtained through their affiliation with the organization, other than to persons who have a legitimate or legal need for such information.

**Section 15.3 Conflict of Interest.** Officers, the Board of Directors and members shall act in the best interest of GFWC, GFWC-NC and District VI. They shall be disqualified from acting when they have any actual or potential conflict of interest that may impede or be perceived as impeding their capacity to act in good faith in the best interest of GFWC District VI.

- A. **Presumption of Conflict.** A conflict of interest shall be presumed when:
1. An officer or member of the Board of Directors; or
  2. Any individual acting in that capacity for a member or constituent division; or

3. A member of their immediate family has a close affiliation or interest in an affected organization or company or could expect financial gain or loss from a matter being considered by GFWC District VI.
- B. Public Positions. No officer, member of the Board of Directors, or member, while acting in their official capacity, may take a public position on any issue:
  1. That is not in conformity with the official position of GFWC District VI; or
  2. On which GFWC, GFWC-NC and/or District VI has taken no formal position.

**Section 15.4 Discrimination.** GFWC shall not discriminate against any person based on race, color, religion, gender, national origin, disability, age or sexual orientation.

# District VI Policies and Procedures

## 1. General

- A. Policies and Procedures for the District may be adopted at any meeting of the District Executive Committee by a majority vote without prior notice. They may be amended, suspended or rescinded by the District Executive Committee. A report of action taken in this manner shall be ratified and made a part of the minutes of the next meeting of the Board of Directors. Notice of changes to appear in the next **publication** following adoption or by announcement at the next meeting of the District.
- B. All activities of District VI shall be carried out in accordance with the Bylaws and Policies and Procedures of GFWC-NC as printed in the current **GFWC-NC Administration Book**.
- C. The current **GFWC-NC Administration Book** shall serve as reference in all matters in which it does not differ specifically with the Bylaws of District VI.

2. **Finances.** Per member numbers are taken from the current membership numbers at GFWC-NC Headquarters as of November 30<sup>th</sup>.
  - A. Each club shall pay an annual fee of \$25.00, which shall cover membership in the District. This fee shall be paid with the dues by December 31<sup>st</sup>.
  - B. District dues shall be paid at the rate of \$4.00 per member. These dues are to be sent by the club to the District Treasurer no later than December 31<sup>st</sup>.  
Emergency recommendations for a per member dues increase shall be made by the Finance Committee to the Executive Committee. On-line approval by the Board of Directors is acceptable as long as all members of the Board are able to participate and vote in the same manner.
  - C. The District Executive Committee, working with the Hostess Clubs, shall set a registration fee for the Annual Meeting and the Arts Festival sufficient to cover the:

1. Rent for the meeting place and any related expenses
  2. Cost of the meal for an individual clubwoman. (While, the Cost of the Coffee Hour is the responsibility of the Hostess Club, when there is no meal function, the District may reimburse the hostess club for expenses.)
  3. Cost of meals and lodging for special guests
  4. Mileage for GFWC-NC officer guests
- D. The Treasurer shall purchase a District President's Pin, a Past President's Guard and Past Director of Juniors' Guard prior to the GFWC-NC Convention in even years.
  - E. The savings of the District were created as rainy day funds. Invested at the highest return possible at the District's bank, these funds may be accessed to balance the budget. The reserve shall be at least \$5000.
- 3. Records and Administration Yearbooks**
- A. District Administration Yearbooks shall be provided to members of the Board of Directors, to Past District Presidents and Past Directors of Juniors who are dues paying members in a District club **via print or electronic media**. Additional copies may be purchased at cost.
  - B. All records and materials pertaining to the work of the District shall be the property of the District. A copy of computer-generated document(s) shall be sent to the District President and District Secretary by electronic media upon completion. Each officer and chairman shall contact her successor and turn over to her all records and materials and shall orient her successor to her on-going responsibilities.
  - C. The District President shall mail or email the Official Call at least 30 days prior to each District Meeting. When emailed, Return Receipt Requested, when applicable, should be added so that the **President** can verify receipt. The Call shall be sent to members of the District Board of Directors, to Past District Presidents and Past District Directors of Juniors who are dues paying members of a District Club, to members of the District serving GFWC-NC and GFWC, to the GFWC-NC President, President-elect, Vice Presidents and to all GFWC and GFWC-NC Past Presidents and Directors of Juniors residing in the District.
  - D. Historical records of the District shall be in the possession of the current President.
- 4. Resignations**
- A. Resignation from District elected office should be made in writing to the District President who shall activate the District Nominating Committee.
  - B. The District President should send pertinent information, along with the name and address of the new officer, as soon as possible to the GFWC-NC Executive Director.
- 5. Junior Sessions.** The Director of Juniors shall designate, with the consent of the District President and the Hostess Club, a time and place for a meeting for the sharing of ideas among District VI Juniors. An Official Call shall be sent to all Junior Clubwomen in the District via Club Presidents, to all District Officers and to other invited guests deemed appropriate. The date and city of this meeting shall be listed in the District Calendar.
- 6. Arts Festival**
- A. The District Arts Chairman, working with the District President, shall be responsible for planning and coordinating the District VI Arts Festival in accordance with the rules and regulations outlined in the current GFWC-NC Arts Festival Brochure. District clubs shall host the District Arts Festival on a rotating schedule as determined by the Executive Committee, which shall also set the date and city. The schedule of Hostess club and years serving shall

be printed in the District Administration Yearbook and the date and city of the Festival shall be printed in the District Calendar.

- B. The Hostess Clubs, working with the District Arts Chairman and the District President, shall be responsible for conducting registration (note Section 2-C), for making arrangements for the meal, the costs of the Coffee Hour, and for providing the set-ups at the site, which are needed to accommodate the Festival activities.
- C. The District President shall be responsible for preparing the Call and the printed program for the Festival.
- D. The District Contest Chairmen working with the District Arts Chairman shall be responsible for securing judges, preparing for the presentation of certificates and awards and for forwarding the winning entries to the appropriate State Chairmen. The District Treasurer shall prepare the cash awards for presentation to student art(s) winners.
- E. The Sallie Southall Cotten, Teaching Scholarship, and Mary K. Whitener Scholarship Chairmen shall be responsible for conducting these contests in accordance with the rules and regulations outlined in the current **GFWC-NC Administration Book**. They shall present these awards at the designated time at the Arts Festival.
- F. Should an award winner not be present to receive the certificate and an applicable award, the sponsoring Club President or her representative shall be responsible for receiving the award and/or certificate for presentation to the winner.

## 7. District Meetings

- A. The District President shall be responsible for planning and coordinating all District Meetings. She shall send the Call and prepare the printed program. The District clubs shall host these meetings on a rotating schedule. The Executive Committee shall be responsible for naming the Hostess Clubs and for selecting the city of these meetings. At each Annual Meeting, the Hostess Club(s) for the following meeting shall issue an invitation for acceptance by the presiding officer. The schedule of Hostess Clubs and the years serving shall be printed in the District Administration Yearbook and the date and city shall be printed in the District Calendar.
- B. The Hostess Clubs, working with the District President, shall be responsible for arranging for lodging of visiting GFWC-NC Officers. In keeping with GFWC-NC policy, the Hostess Clubs shall be responsible for arranging for dinner for the visiting Officer(s) at a convenient location on the evening prior to the meeting. The District President and the District Director of Juniors should be extended an invitation to the dinner along with any other guests whom the Hostess Clubs wish to include. The Hostess Clubs shall be responsible for the arrangements for and costs of the Coffee Hour (see 2. Finances 2.) preceding the meeting, decorating the facility, and table favors (which may be provided at the discretion of the Hostess Clubs). The gifts should reflect the talent of Clubwomen rather than be costly purchases.
- C. The District shall be responsible for all of the costs of the meeting including the lodging and all meals for the GFWC-NC guests, printing of the program for the meeting, printing and mailing the Call, and any signs and/or similar set-ups. The registration fee should be set so as to cover these expenses.
- D. Door prizes at District meetings may be provided by the clubs of the District, one prize per club for one meeting in alternate years at the discretion of the District President. The District

President may assign the clubs this responsibility for the Annual Meeting by notification in the Newsletter with the Call.

8. **Hostess Clubs' Schedule Review.** The Hostess Clubs schedule (and times of service) shall be reviewed and adjusted annually by the Executive Committee.
9. **Some Special Committees and Appointments made by the President.**
  - A. Community Improvement Program (CIP). The Community Improvement Chairman promotes the Community Improvement Program in the District. She encourages the participation of clubs in the District.
  - B. **GFWC Clubwoman/North Carolina Clubwoman** Chairmen shall promote these publications and assist the GFWC-NC Editor as the need arises.
  - C. Historian. The President shall appoint a Historian who shall compile a brief summary of the significant events and outstanding projects of the Administration during which she serves. At the discretion of the President, she may prepare a scrapbook for the President as a permanent record of her presidency. Historical records of the District shall be in the possession of the current President.
  - D. Parliamentarian. The President shall appoint a Parliamentarian to attend all meetings of the Executive Committee, Board of Directors, Summer Meeting, Annual Meeting, and Arts Festival to insure that all proceedings of these meetings are in conformity with **Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised**.
  - E. Public Relations. The Public Relations Chairman shall publicize the District meetings and activities in cooperation with the District President.
10. **Approval before publication of Official Documents.** All changes made to official documents shall be approved with official signature by the Bylaws Committee as well as the Secretary.
11. **The District Seal.** The seal was redesigned as a means of enhancing the cohesiveness, recognition and solidarity of our progressive District and adopted on October 19, 2006. The seal is:
  - A. A hexagon (a 6-sided symbol – representing District VI) is the foundation of the District VI seal.
  - B. One of the 6 points of the hexagon points upward representing courage and constancy.
  - C. The GFWC-NC seal – The North Carolina Federation's official seal was adopted in January 1913 during the administration of State President, Mrs. Robert R. Cotten (Sallie Southall), of Farmville. It included "a circle surrounding the words 'North Carolina Federation of Women's Clubs,' with a sprig of pine, the Federation emblem in the center."\* The seal was redesigned in 1998 to incorporate the new name: GFWC of North Carolina, and – covers part of the hexagon representing our part of GFWC-NC showing that Federation means to be governed from the base upward.
  - D. The identifying words: "District VI" appear inside the hexagon under the State seal.
  - E. Color. The official color is reflex blue #255. Black is always an appropriate color when the seal is reproduced.
